Parking at Calf Pasture Beach is free for residents with Norwalk beach stickers on their cars. Without a beach sticker the parking fee is \$5 per car. On Friday, July 3, Norwalk hosts its Independence Day fireworks display that typically attracts more than 20,000 spectators; a fee of \$20 is charged for cars without a Norwalk beach sticker. Cars with beach stickers will be allowed in free.
