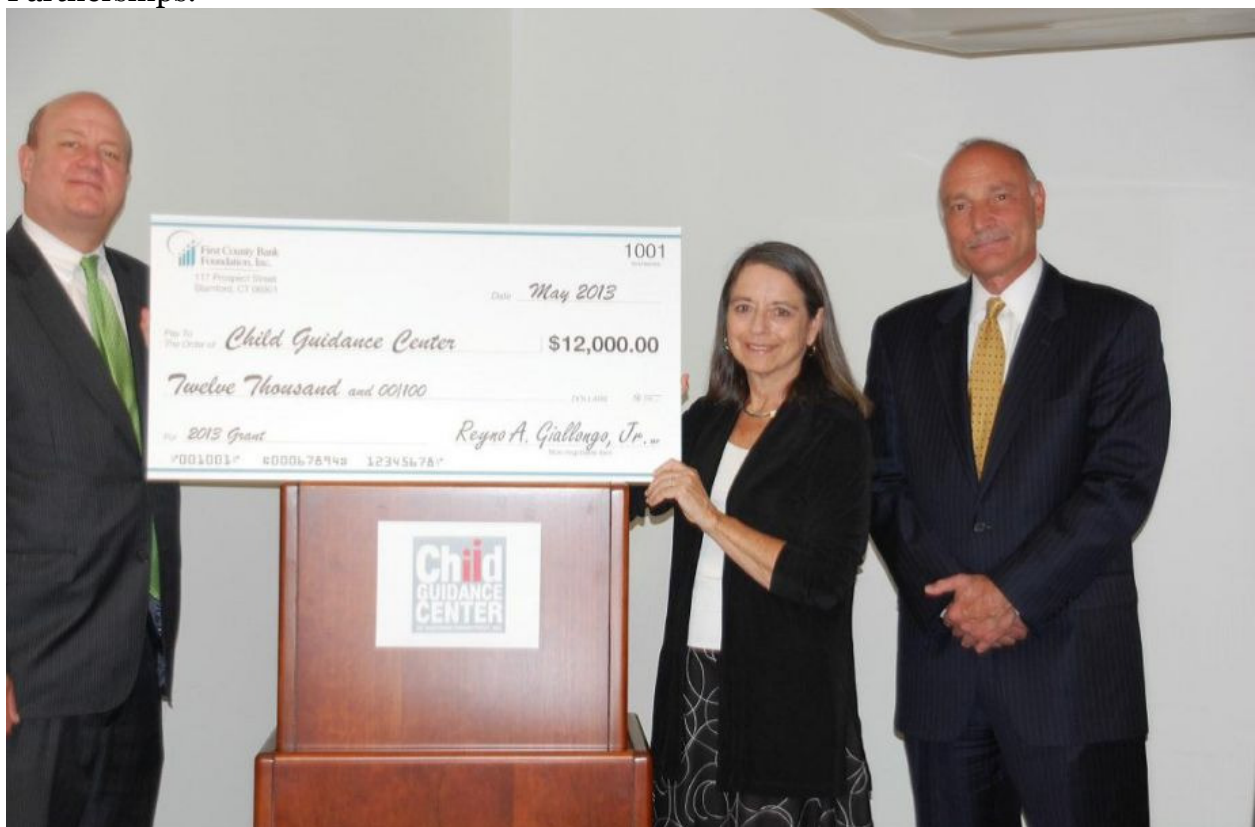


Greenwich's nonprofits invited to First County Bank celebration of 2015 grants

After awarding \$544,000 in grants to 88 local nonprofits in 2015, the First County Bank Foundation celebrated the awards with its seventh annual "Celebration of Mutual Partnerships."
