

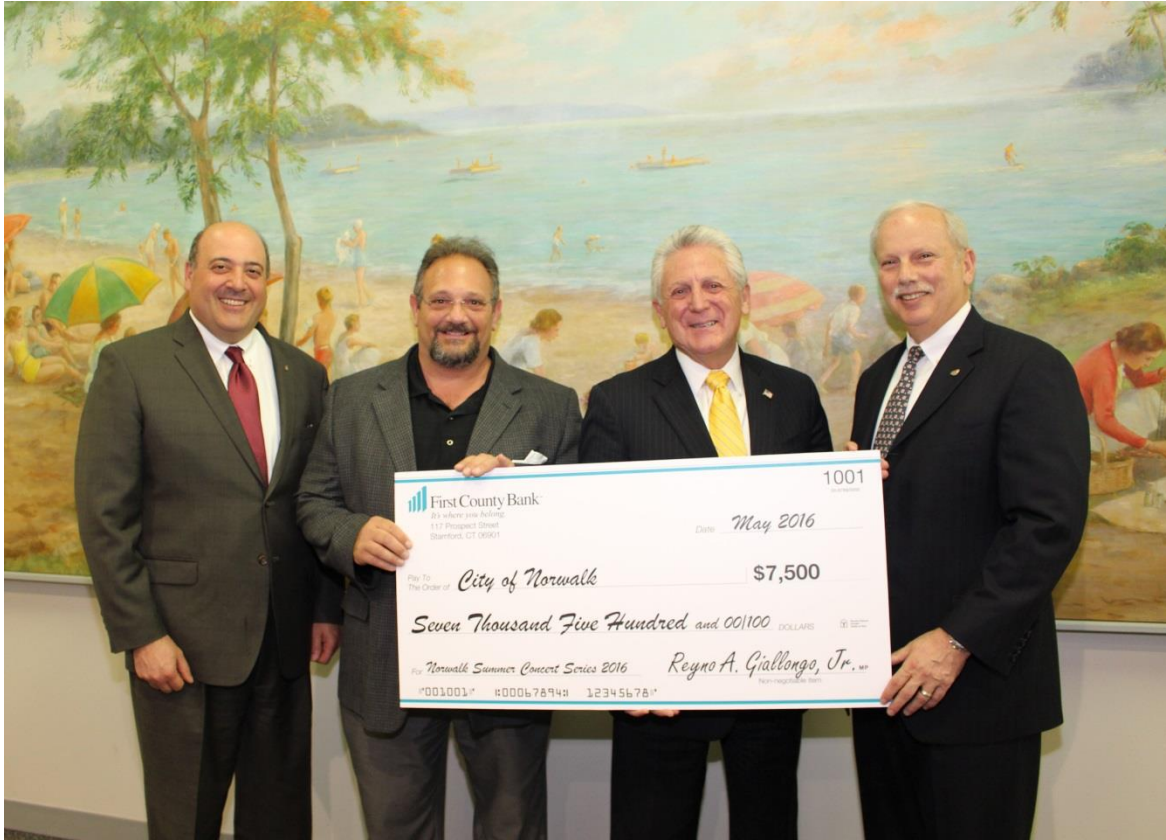

Parking at Calf Pasture Beach is free for residents with a Norwalk Resident Pass on their cars. Without a Norwalk Resident Pass the parking fee is \$10 per car. For the July 3 Independence Day fireworks display which typically attracts more than 20,000 spectators, a fee of \$30 is charged for cars without a Norwalk Resident Pass while cars with the pass will be allowed in free.
