Inspirica was recently awarded a \$10,000 grant from First County Bank to support its work with the homeless in Lower Fairfield County.

The organization provides emergency shelter, transitional housing, permanent supportive housing and a holistic approach that tackles underlying reasons for homelessness with services that provide clients with access to education, employment programs, health care, and mental health and substance abuse problems.

“We are grateful for their generous support of our mission, but even more importantly, for their partnership,” said Inspirica CEO Jason Shaplen.

Over the past three years, the organization has placed 568 clients in jobs and helped 448 homeless people find housing.
